The Forge Participation Release for Participants

The Catherine Creek Christian Youth Camp, Inc. ("**CCCYC**") is an Oregon nonprofit corporation that owns and maintains a Christian youth camp located at 53800 Oregon State Highway 203, Union, Oregon 97883 (the "**Forge**"). The Forge is available to various youth organizations and their members and guests. The undersigned for himself or herself or his or her minor child or children identified below (each a "**Participant**") desires to accompany the "**Organization**" identified below to access and use the Forge to camp and engage in related activities at the Forge, including without limitation rappelling, archery, use of the climbing wall, obstacle course, hatchet throwing, hiking, and many other activities (the "**Activities**"). As a charitable, nonprofit organization operated by volunteers, CCCYC cannot allow the Participant to use the Forge unless the Participant is willing to fully release CCCYC from liability, and waive all claims for any injury, disability, damages, or death to maximum extent permitted by law.

CCCYC hereby agrees to allow the Participant to access and use the Forge to engage in the Activities in exchange for the Participant's agreement to the terms and conditions set forth in this "**Release**."

1. <u>Compliance with Guidelines</u>. The Participant agrees to comply with any written or oral rules and guidelines provided by CCCYC from time to time.

2. Release, Waiver, and Assumption of Risk. To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Participant hereby expressly waives and releases forever any and all claims against CCCYC and its owners, members, officers, directors, agents, or volunteers (together with CCCYC, the "CCCYC Parties", or individually a "CCCYC Party") on account of personal injury, disability, death, property damage, or other loss arising out of or attributable to a Participant's presence at the Forge or participation in the Activities, whether or not arising out of the negligence of a CCCYC Party. The Participant covenants not to make or bring any such claim against any CCCYC Party, and forever release and discharge all CCCYC Parties from liability under such claims. The Participant is aware and understands that the Activities are dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury, disability, death, property damage and/or other loss and that these risks may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of the CCCYC Parties. The Participant understands that while CCCYC has implemented measures to reduce the risk, CCCYC cannot and does not guarantee that the Participant will not be injured while at the Forge or engaging in the Activities. Notwithstanding these risks, the Participant acknowledges that the Participant is voluntarily accessing the Forge and engaging in the Activities with knowledge of the dangers involved. The Participant hereby agrees to accept and assume all risks of personal injury, disability, death, property damage, and/or other loss arising therefrom, whether or not caused by the negligence of a CCCYC Party. The Participant accepts the Forge and all aspects thereof and facilities thereon in "AS IS", "WHERE IS" condition, without warranties, either express or implied, "with all faults." The Participant hereby waives all warranties, express or implied, regarding the condition and use of the Forge. The Participant disclaims any duties that CCCYC may otherwise owe to the Participant. No actions or omissions of CCCYC shall be deemed an assumption of any duties not expressly assumed by CCCYC in writing.

A separate Release must be completed and signed for each Participant, and a paper, physical copy of this Release must be provided to CCCYC upon arrival at the Forge. The undersigned represents and warrants that he or she has the necessary authority to sign this Release on behalf of the Participant.
